Using assistive technology is an essential part of life for the people with disabilities. Six years after the 2004 amendments to the Assistive Technology Act of 1998, 20 percent of the United State Assistive Technology Programs have yet to receive the \$410,000 minimum grant award authorized in the Act. Many states have limited or no alternative finance programs.

As you see, I use a communication device which helps me to communicate with you and others. If Virginia limits the funding for assistive technology, people with disabilities, including me, would have difficult lives in the community. We would not able to purchase the devices we need to continue to live in the community such as a wheelchair, a communication device, and a transfer chair.
